



Queen Cutlery Guide

1970s and early '80's Sales Fliers

As Queen relied on Catalog #50 (1972-till the end of 1979) while worked on their modernization as a "collector-oriented" company, they began to use color sales fliers to announce special edition knives. We have NOT found a sales flier for the companies first effort, the Drake Well barlow commemorating 50 years of the company's founding. There were 3,600 of that knife produced and as you can see in the early '80s fliers below, they still had them almost a decade later. This might have pushed the company toward more emphasis on sales fliers, such as we see for the Kentucky set and the "Master Cutler" fliers later in the '70s, attached .

Although Queen Cutlery did produce colored catalogs beginning with the 1980 catalog, they also had a series of "New for a year – 1980-'83" attached. The last item, an 1984 Shot show special – a beautiful stag lock back – for FREE – if you stopped by their booth. Seems like a very expensive gesture to promote a difficult launch of a their collector effort.

The middle of the decade, '84-"86 have been the very hardest of the Queen Cutlery Company history to find advertising material – it was a very lean time for the company. By the end of the decade, you can find more information on the Price list section for the 80s.

Each knife has a serial number from 00001 to 10,000. The serial numbers are imprinted near

the top of the brass liner of the pile side of the knife so they can be read from the mark side. The two knives have matching serial numbers. The red handles are the color of Kentucky's State Bird, the Cardinal.

The cover of the mark side of each knife has a nickel-silver embossed shield shaped like the map of Kentucky. The master blade of each knife has a distinctive etch. The 4-inch knife commemorates the Kentucky Bicentennial, the 2¾-inch knife the 100th running of the Derby on May 4, 1974.

Collectors will rush to get this unusual commemorative and the net cost of \$15.00 per set will enable you to easily get at least \$30.00 retail. Don't forget, order today to assure you get a supply before the offer is over subscribed. Better put one or more sets away for yourself, too, as only 10,000 sets will be made.
