Queen Price Lists from 1949 to 2012

Price lists have been considered very useful among collectors. Like catalogs, they show the time of introduction and duration of offering a knife more completely than catalogs.

Two nice examples:

The Drake Oil well commemorative (#139) was available much after it was heavily announced in catalogs.

The lever-lock skinner (#396) in the gamekeeper series was never included in a catalog, only in a very few price lists.

Of course, the price lists also show manufacturers sale prices to distributors - which will allow you to see the increase in knife prices for a particular pattern, or how it compared with other patterns at the time of sale. Newer price lists allow you to compare the distributors price to the price you paid.

You also see changes in these critical sales documents, from the very basic one-page of the early years, to the legal size in the 1990s, and the multi-page color versions of the 2000s.

To our knowledge, no paper copies of price lists were available during the Daniels Family era, after 2013. This is a very comprehensive list. I would like to thank Fred Fisher, David Clark, and John Lussier for their help in assembling this set over many years.
